Announcement was made today of the marriage of Lieut. Anne Mesko, of the U. S. Army Nurse Corps, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. Mesko, 1711 East Second Street, this city, to Lieut. Andrew W. O'Rorke, Jr., U. S. Marine Corps, son of Mr. and Mrs. A. W. O'Rorke, Sr., Harrison, N. Y.

The wedding took place "somewhere in Australia" on September 18, 1943. Parents were notified by cable.

Lieut. Anne (Mesko) O'Rorke is a graduate of Bethlehem High School and St. Luke's Hospital School of Nursing. She entered the U. S. Army Nurse Corps December 3, 1940, and was stationed at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey. For the past two years she has been on duty overseas "somewhere in Australia."

Lieut. Andrew O'Rorke, formerly of Rochelle, New York, has been in the U. S. Marine Corps eight years. He has been in action in Guadalcanal and is now in action "somewhere in the southwest Pacific area."
