Wounded in Action

Corporal Norman Wissler, son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Babio, 801 Fourth Street, is somewhere in the South Pacific area recuperating from wounds received on that battlefield, his parents learned recently.

The young man enlisted in the Army five years ago. When the Japs struck at Pearl Harbor, he was 20 miles from that spot. Since that day he has moved from one island to another in pursuit. Last week he was awarded the Purple Heart for gallantry in action.

Corporal Wissler's brother, Private John Raymond Peino, age 19, a graduate of Broughal High School, was inducted May 26, 1943. On February 27 of this year, he reached England and details of his participation in the conflict are now unknown.

August 17, 1944
