**First Honorable Discharge  
Lapel Emblem Issued 1944**

Raymond Kline, clerk in the Allentown Post Office, who served two years and five months in the U. S. Army, became the first recipient of the new honorable discharge lapel emblem at the Allentown Armed Forces Induction Station yesterday.

Henceforth, Captain Carroll said, the buttons will be available for all former soldiers who have been honorably discharged since September 8, 1939. Officers and enrolled members of the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps or the WAC who have been honorably discharged are also eligible. No provisions for Navy or Marine personnel have as yet been made.

Applicants must bring their discharge papers or certificates of service to the induction center and report to the reception clerk or to Sergeant Wilmont Hummel.
