## Report Local Soldier As Missing

A veteran of campaigns in North Africa and some of the major engagements on Italian soil, Sgt. Michael Ferrani, 29-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Nicholas Ferrani, of 129 Crest Avenue, has been reported missing in action in Germany since September 18, according to a telegram from the War Department, received today by his parents.

Following a training in camps in this country, he participated in the invasion of North Africa, was with the American troops that invaded Sicily and Italy, and was one of three Bethlehemites who were transferred to England to assist in the training of troops preparatory to the invasion of France. He was wounded "somewhere in France" on June 17.

He has two brothers in service, Technician S-c. Stephen Ferrani, and Pfc. John Ferrani, both in the U. S. Medical Corps, stationed on foreign soil.
