A veteran of the fighting in Europe with the 44th Division of the Seventh Army, Cpl. Geza E. Gubish, son of Mrs. Joseph Gubish, 218 Hobart Street, this city, is spending a 30-day furlough at home.

Overseas 15 months, Cpl. Gubish served in England, France, Germany and Austria. He has been in the service three and one-half years.

He wears the Combat Infantry badge, the Presidential Unit Citation with a wreath, and the ETO ribbon with three battle stars.

At the conclusion of the furlough, he will report to Indiantown Gap for redeployment.
