

Lt. Whitehead "Missing" After European Raid

Ronald Raymond Whitehead, 22, son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond C. Whitehead, Butztown R. D. 1, was listed today as "missing in action."

A second lieutenant in the U. S. Army Air Corps, he was reported in a telegram to his parents by the War Department to have been missing since January 24.

His latest mission, the telegram states, was a flight over Yugoslavia. He is a member of the 15th U. S. Army Air Force, stationed in Italy.

Lieut. Whitehead received his silver wings and his commission January 4, 1943 after successfully completing Air Force Advanced Training at Williams Field, Arizona. He graduated from Liberty High School and was employed by Bethlehem Steel Company.

His father was in the Naval Air Forces during the first World War.
