Quakertown Navy Man's Unit Carried "Unlucky" Number on Lucky Voyage

Paul A. Mitman, 19, seaman 1/C, carried an unlucky number through

a lucky voyage to be among the first American Naval personnel to move into Shanghai, China, after the end of hostilities.

His unit, which carried this distinction was organized under the mysterious name of NABU—13, or Naval Advance Base Unit 13.
