## Wounded



Pfc. William Zatovich, son of Mrs. Maria Zatovich, River Road, Route 3, Bethlehem, is now confined to Northampton General Hospital, Tuscaloosa, Ala., recovering from wounds of the legs received in Italy. He suffered his wounds October 13, 1943, and was in a base hospital in North Africa until brought to the United States recently. He expects to be transferred to a hospital closer to home and then receive a sick leave. He was inducted June 12, 1942, and received basic training at Fort George G. Meade, Md. He was sent abroad in January, 1943, and participated in battles in North Africa, Sicily and Italy before being wounded. He has been awarded the Purple Heart. He graduated from Allentown High School and was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before his induction.
