Private First Class William Kametler, previously reported missing in action, has informed his parents he is being held a prisoner of war by Germany. He stated further that he had been wounded but was "improving."
The son of Mr. and Mrs. John Kametler, 65 Crest Avenue, he enlisted in the armed forces in June, 1941, and for 21 months was connected with an antiaircraft unit in Jamaica and Puerto Rico. After his return to the States, he trained with the infantry and was again sent overseas in September of last year.
