T/5 Jerry Yoder, 263 Ninth Avenue, is being processed by the Assembly Area Command at Camp Washington in northeastern France.

After 141 days of combat, including the battle of Hurtgen Forest, south of Aachen, the 817 Tank Destroying Battalion gained fame in the ETO as one of the first tank destroyer battalions to cross the Remagen bridge and hold it against continuous German counterattacks.

T/5 Yoder is the husband of Mrs. Jerry Yoder, 244 East Union Street. He will spend 30 days in the States before leaving for Pacific duty.
