Staff Sergeant Harry F. Tachovsky Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Tachovsky Sr., 1 Finady Avenue, previously reported as missing in action since September 27, is now reported as being a prisoner of war in Germany.

S-Sgt. Tachovsky, a waist gunner on a bomber, entered the Air Corps after graduating from Bethlehem High School. He was sent to Keesler Field where he completed his training and was awarded his wings.

He holds the coveted Air Medal and four Oak Leaf Clusters awarded to him the four months he was in action with the U. S. Eighth Air Force.
