Paratrooper Killed March 24 APR 11 1945 In Germany

Pfc. Richard R. Mowrey, 19-year-old son of William and Ida S. (Koch) Mowrey, Bethlehem R. D. 4, was killed in action in Germany on March 24, according to an official notification received today by his parents.

A member of the 194th Airborne Division, he was inducted into the armed forces on April 6, 1943, received his preliminary training at

Camp Mackall, N. C., and Camp Forrest, Tenn. He was sent overseas on August 2, 1944, and for some time was based in England.

At the time of his induction he was a junior at Mellertown High School. Athletically inclined, he was a pitcher on the school's varsity baseball team, and was also a member of the soccer team. He also pitched for the Bingen Dukes.

Besides his parents, he is survived by four brothers, Pfc. Elmer Mowrey, Camp Lee, Va.; Milton M., U. S. Navy; Sylvanus and Russell R., Bethlehem, and a sister, Lottie E., at home.
