Mr. and Mrs. Paul Lakics, Butztown, received the Purple Heart awarded to their son, Corporal William Lakics, for wounds received in Normandy, and word of the promotion of their son, Alfred Lakics, to Private First Class in the U. S. Marine Corps. Corporal William entered the service in December, 1942, and was sent to England in January, 1944. He took part in the D-Day invasion and has seen action in France, Belgium and Germany. Pfc. Alfred entered the service in January, 1944, and received his training at camps in Carolina and Virginia prior to being sent overseas in April, 1944. He is stationed somewhere in the Pacific at present. Another brother, Pvt. James Lakics, is serving with the Medical Corps in France.
