Albert Groeger Seriously Hurt On Italian Soil

Pvt. Albert Groeger, 25, was seriously wounded on April 16, in action in Italy, according to a War Department telegram received yesterday by his father, Adolph Groeger, 817 Carlton Avenue.

He was inducted into the armed forces in March, 1944, received his training at Camp Swift, Tex., and Camp Wheeler, Ga., and went overseas in December. He was assigned to the 87th Mountain Infantry, a ski troop unit.

A graduate of Liberty High School, he was a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
