Killed In Action



Staff Sgt. Dezso Benczik is reported killed in action in a telegram from the War Department received by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Benczik, Market Street, Freemansburg.

The 20-year-old Infantryman left for training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., in March, 1942. From here he continued his training overseas in England and Ireland, and was sent to the front in France last June. He had served with Gen. Patton's Third Army and was previously reported missing in action November 18, 1944, in France.
