## Lt. Thompson Is Reported Killed in Action

A telegram from the War Department, delivered Saturday, reported that Lieutenant William Shimer Thompson, son of William J. Thompson, 1116 Main Street, was killed in action on the Cassino front.

Friends and neighbors have been endeavoring to get in touch with Lieutenant Thompson's father, who is out of town. The Rev. P. T. Stengele, pastor of the Ebenezer Mennonite Church and a neighbor of Mr. Thompson, announced the contents of the telegram at church services yesterday.

Lieutenant Thompson was a member of College Hill Moravian Church, a graduate of Liberty High School and Moravian College, from which he received his B.S. in 1937.

May 20, 1944
