Hellertown Soldier Sent To Columbus

He won his wings on June 26, 1943, at Lubbock, Tex., and took his previous flying training at Jones Field and Perrin Field, Tex.

He has since seen service in the European Theatre of Operations as a combat pilot where he was decorated with the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters.
