Lt. Jackson Sigmon Chosen To Take Oxford Course

Lt. Jackson M. Sigmon, son of Mr. and Mrs. William L. Sigmon, currently serving as legal officer in the Military Government of Offenbach, has just returned from a temporary duty status in England. Attorney Sigmon was chosen by the American Seventh Army to take a course at Oxford University, England, in world politics and problems.

While at Oxford, he was one of 65 students who represented many of the Allied Nations, including the USA, England, New Zealand, Australia, Canada and Poland. He has

written that the course was most interesting and enlightening.

Sigmon, who resides at 522 West Third Street, is a member of the Northampton Bar Association, and is a graduate of Pittsburgh, Fletcher School of Harvard and Duke University.
