Charles J. Miller *Oct 26*
Gets Commendation
For Navy Work

Charles J. Miller, Machinist's Mate 3/C, USNR, whose wife lives at 1129 North Main Street, has since April, 1944, contributed materially to the success of the U. S. naval submarine base, Pearl Harbor, in repairing and maintenance work on submarines operating in the Pacific Ocean area. *Oct 26 1945*

Miller was commended for his "extreme devotion to duty and hard work over long periods of time in overhauling, repairing and refitting fleet submarines after arduous war patrols, sent these submarines to sea in excellent material condition in the least possible time."

Before entering the Navy in February, 1943, Miller was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. He attended Bethlehem Technical High School.
