Freemansburg Para- Trooper Home-Bound

WITH THE 11TH AIRBORNE DIVISION, in Funaoka, Japan (delayed).—Sgt. Russell D. Green, 22-year-old Freemansburg, Pa., paratrooper with the 11th Airborne, is now on his way home. How soon he will arrive there depends on shipping facilities and the speed at which the replacement depot can turn him out, but he has been re-

lieved from active duty and transferred to a separation center.

Green, a veteran of New Guinea, Leyte and Luzon, entered the Army in March, 1943. He qualified as a parachutist at Oro Bay, New Guinea, in August, 1944.

He will be wearing the Asiatic Pacific Ribbon with three battle stars, the Philippine Liberation Ribbon and the Combat Infantryman's Badge.

When inducted, Green was working as a grinder at Bethlehem Steel. His mother, Mrs. Mabel S. Green, lives at 827 Main St.
