## Three Soldier Buddies Plan Reunion Here

Three soldier buddies who were drafted together May 29, 1943, and took part in five major battles after going overseas in the same unit, expect to stage a reunion today and celebrate their discharge from the Army.

Pfc. Robert F. Greenamoyer, 1114 Center Street, and Pfc. Walter Chickersky, 1806 East Third Street, two of the trio, landed in Hoboken, N. J., last Tuesday and were discharged at Indiantown Gap Saturday. The third member of the trio, Corporal Theodore Halkias, 438 East Fairview Street, is expected to land in New York today.

The soldiers were all members of the 166th Photo Company and served overseas in the ETO for 21 months. They completed their training at Camp Crowder after their induction, and were sent overseas with a fighting unit of the 3rd Army. Together they went through Ireland, England, France, Luxemburg, Germany and Czechoslovakia, and were separated for the first time at a staging area in France, when Cpl. Halkias was assigned to a different ship.

After taking a long rest, Greenamoyer and Halkias intend to return to school. Chickersky will probably return to his former place of employment.
