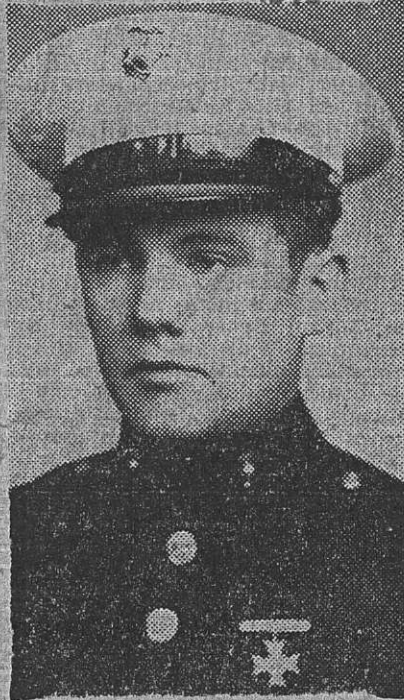

Pfc. Domiter Dies in Battle For Okinawa

Pfc. Joseph Domiter, 25, was killed in action on Okinawa June 16, according to a telegram from the War Department received by his brother, Charles Domiter, 1003 East Fourth Street, where he resided prior to enlisting in the Marine Corps on May 18, 1942.

Pfc. Joseph Domiter received his training at Parris Island, N. C., and was stationed overseas in Ireland for 19 months. Following his return home on a 30-day leave, he received further training at New River, N. C., and Camp Pendleton, Calif. Seven months ago he was sent to the South Pacific, where he served with the 1st Marine Division.
