S/Sgt. Paul Borger, Northampton, who served in the 11th Field Artillery Battalion of the 24th (Victory) Division, one of the two Army divisions outside the continental limits of the United States when the Japanese pulled their sneak attack on Pearl Harbor, has been assigned to Headquarters in the Field Artillery School at Fort Sill, Okla.

S/Sgt. Borger entered the Army in 1939 and was stationed in Hawaii, Dec. 7, 1941. His division moved on to Australia and into the New Guinea campaign.

Borger and his wife, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Warren J. Smith, 1788 Main St., Northampton, are now residing in Lawton, Okla.
