**Lt. Franklin Werner,  
Bangor, on Duty  
In McGuire Hospital 1945**

Assignment of Lieut. Franklin C. Werner, Medical Corps, to duty at McGuire General Hospital Richmond, Va., is announced today by Col. P. E. Duggins, hospital commanding officer.

A native of Bangor, Lieut. Werner was graduated from Dickinson College with the B. S. degree in 1940 and received the M. D. degree from the University of Pennsylvania. Following internship at Kansas City General Hospital, he entered military service July 1, 1943, and was commissioned September 23, 1944. Previous assignments include those at Valley Forge General Hospital and at Carlisle Medical Field Service School.

Lieut. Werner is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry H. Werner, 134 Broadway, Bangor.

McGuire General Hospital, the largest named medical installation operated by the Army in the Third Service Command, has been designated as one of seven amputation centers in the United States and also specializes in neurosurgery and neurology.
