Local Marine Wounded In Action

Pfc. William J. Ronyack, U. S. Marine Corps, son of Mr. and Mrs. Rudolph Ronyack, of 251 Eighth Avenue, wounded in action in the South Pacific theater of operations, is getting along nicely, according to information received by his parents.

He participated in the Bougainville and Guam campaigns, and was wounded during the latter battle. Following treatment at a base hospital he was transferred to California.

According to a letter from the young man, he will receive the Purple Heart at ceremonies in the near future, to be held at a hospital.

Joining the armed forces in December, 1942, he received his basic training at Parris Island, S. C., subsequently being assigned to New River, N. C., thence to San Diego, Cal. He is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
