Pvt. Frank J. Wentzel, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Wentzel Bethlehem R. D. 4, died March 29 from wounds received while fighting with the Third Army in Germany. A member of an infantry division, Pfc. Wentzel has been serving overseas since August, 1944. He was inducted December 21, 1943, and sent to Camp Croft, S. C., and Camp Rucker, Ala., to complete his training. He is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company and a graduate of Lower Saucon Township schools.
