### Four Local Soldiers Win Commendation

Four Bethlehem soldiers have won high commendation for helping to shatter world records overhauling aircraft engines at the Air Service Command depot with the Strategic Air Forces in Europe.

The men are: Pfc. Gordon R. Fenicle, son of Mr. and Mrs. H. W. Fenicle, 1124 Maple Street; Cpl. John L. Reagan, son of Mr. and Mrs. John A. Reagan, 1113 Russell Avenue; Pvt. Edward Lazar, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Lazar, and Pfc. C. Jay Spangenberg, son of Mr. and Mrs. C. F. Spangenberg.

They and their fellow mechanics overhauled engines last month totaling two and a half million horsepower, the highest figure recorded since Air Service Command began operations in England.
