## Northampton Public Health Nurse Joins Army Corps

Miss Lillian Dilliard, R. N., has resigned as public health nurse in Northampton borough to accept a commission in the Army Nursing Corps, effective September 1, according to an announcement made Sunday by Rev. Sidney S. Smith, chairman of the Northampton branch, American Red Cross, and Mrs. J. Fred Kline, chairman of the Northampton nursing activities committee.

Miss Dilliard has been commissioned a second lieutenant and will report for duty September 2.

A native of Northampton, Miss Dilliard is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Dilliard, 2366 Washington Avenue. She is a graduate of the Northampton High School, class of 1920, and was graduated from the Jefferson Hospital, Philadelphia, School of Nursing in 1925.

Following her training period, she served for ten years in the Boro Park General Hospital, also known as Doctor's Hospital, Brooklyn, N. Y.; the Shore Road Hospital, Israel Zion Hospital, and the Cumberland Hospital, all in Brooklyn.

Miss Dilliard is the second Northampton public health nurse to enter the service. Lieutenant Dorothy Berger, R. N., having preceded her.
