John A. Doria Dies of Injuries In Puerto Rico

John A. Doria, S. E., 2-c., son of Mr. and Mrs. Vido Doria, 240 Seventh Avenue, died April 13 as a result of injuries received at the San Juan Naval Air Station, Puerto Rico. According to the Navy Department telegram, burial was made four days after his death at the Naval Air Station.

S. E. 2-c. Doria was a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School and a member of SS. Simon and Jude Church. He was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company prior to enlisting in the Navy Feb. 22, 1944. He had been stationed in Puerto Rico for almost a year.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by a brother, Frank, and a sister, Theresa, at home.
