**Pfc. Russell Gross  
Given Discharge**

Pfc. Russell Gross, 34 East Spruce St., was honorably discharged at Indiantown Gap Dec. 30, 1945, after serving overseas with the 773rd Field Artillery Battalion for 18 months.

Pfc. Gross was inducted July 27, 1943, and after completing his basic training at Fort Bragg, N. C., was sent to Camp Bowie, Tex., and Louisiana for maneuvers. He was awarded the Good Conduct Medal, ETO Ribbon, Victory Medal, five campaign stars and a coveted French citation, while in battle in Germany, France and Belgium. His wife, the former Elizabeth Kery, and mother, Mrs. Stella Schrantz, reside at the Spruce St. address.
