Receives Discharge**

Sgt. John R. Myers Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. John R. Myers, 506 Sioux St., received his honorable discharge from the United States Marine Corps, March 20.

Sgt. Myers was inducted September 6, 1943, and received his boot training at Camp Lejeune, N. C. He received further training in Linda Vista, Calif., before shipping out to the South Pacific, where he served for 24 months in the Russell Islands, Solomons, Pearl Harbor, Okinawa and China.

The ex-Leatherneck wears the Presidential Unit Citation ribbon, Asiatic-Pacific ribbon, Victory medal and a campaign star for the Okinawa operation.
