Private First Class Alexander J. Glass, who was reported wounded in action somewhere in Belgium, according to a notice from the War Department, received by his sister, Mrs. Albert Longo Jr., and is now recuperating in a hospital somewhere in England. Overseas since July, 1944, he has seen action in France, Holland, Belgium and Germany as a member of the 30th Infantry Division, the Old Hickory Division of World War I fame. Pfc. Glass completed his basic training at Fort McClellan, Ala., and Fort George Meade, Md., before going overseas. He was awarded the Purple Heart and Combat Infantry Badge.
