Staff Sergeant John Goor, veteran North African, Tunisian, Sicilian, Italian and French fighter, has been reported missing in action in Germany since November 11 in a War Department telegram received by his brother and sister-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Louis Goor, 1811 East Fourth Street, last night.

During the course of the battles in which he was engaged, he was slightly wounded in the Tunisian campaign. He was inducted February 3, 1942, received his basic infantry training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and was sent overseas from Indian-town Gap in September of 1942.

S-Sgt. Goor is a former bartender at the Washington House and leader of a Hungarian orchestra.
