News has reached Bethlehem of the promotion of Lt. George A. Goetz, (above), Lehigh '38, formerly of Bethlehem and Trenton, N. J., to the rank of first lieutenant. Lt. Goetz entered active service with the army of the United States in March 1942 and is now with an armored division, armored infantry regiment. Since leaving Bethlehem he has been stationed at Fort Benning, Ga., and Camp Polk, La., and now receives mail c/o Postmaster, Los Angeles, Calif.

Lt. Goetz graduated from Lehigh with the degree of Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering in June, 1938. He received his commission in the army of the United States upon the successful completion of advanced ROTC training at Lehigh University. He was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company (electrical department of the Coke Plant) following his graduation from Lehigh until he was called to active duty March, 1942.
