A U. S. TROOP CARRIER BASE, France—Sergeant Robert F. Cassell, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank G. Cassell, 445 Carlton Avenue, Bethlehem, is a member of a Troop Carrier Service Wing unit which was recently awarded the Meritorious Service Unit Plaque.

The honor was awarded for "superior performance of duty in the execution of exceptionally difficult tasks." It covered a period from May 26 to November 25, 1944.

Particularly cited were the maintenance and repair of battle-damaged C-47 Douglas Skytrains and CG-4A gliders of Maj. Gen. Paul L. Williams' U. S. Troop Carrier forces. The commanding officer of the Service Wing is Col. Franklin S. Henley.
