M-Sgt. Edward C. Hawk, 1624 Maple Street, this city, is now serving with the Eastern Command of U. S. Strategic Air Forces in Europe, "Somewhere in Russia," with a contingent of picked American troops that now staffs U. S. bomber and

fighter bases in the Soviet Union.

M-Sgt. Hawk, son of the late Jeremiah Hawk, was among troops dispatched to the Soviet Union by the Army Air Forces, and with their Soviet allies they built bases in what high-ranking American officers described as a "surprisingly short time." Now soldiers of the two nations jointly operate them.
