Cpl. Hudak's return Thursday evening marked the completion of his fifth trip aboard a hospital ship, the latest of which brought wounded home from France. The previous trips were from North Africa and England.

Young Hudak returned to his base, Halloran General Hospital, Staten Island, last evening but expects to get a further leave so that he may spend his birthday anniversary which is tomorrow and the week-end with his parents here.

A few weeks ago Cpl. Hudak was given a salute over Station WSAN on "The Salute to Servicemen" program for his fine work aboard a hospital ship.
