Local Youth Will Graduate July 3  
at U. S. Quartermaster School.

Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Korpics, 122 Graham Court, and Postmaster Urban W. O'Donnell have received invitations to the ceremonies at the U. S. Quartermaster School, Camp Lee, Va., on July 3, at which time Mr. and Mrs. Korpics' son, Cadet Joseph J. Korpics, Jr., will be commissioned a lieutenant. The invitations were sent out by Commandant H. L. Whittaker, of the school.
