**John W. Skłodowski  
With Record-Breaking  
LST Boat Crew**

John W. Skłodowski, S 1/C, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Skłodowski, Route 1, Coopersburg, is one of the crewmen aboard an LST, who break the monotony of otherwise routine shuttle runs across the channel with Allied supplies by setting records—and then breaking them with all out efforts.

On one occasion during the European engagement, his LST hit the beach, discharged her cargo and retracted from the beach in 28 minutes. Skłodowski's wife, Mrs. Gertrude Skłodowski, resides in this city. He was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before entering the service in April, 1944.
