**Arthur A. Andrews Promoted at  
Geiger Field, Washington.**

Arthur A. Andrews, son of Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Andrews, 1122 Center Street, this city, was recently promoted to the rank of sergeant at Geiger Field, Wash., where he is stationed with the U. S. Army Aviation Engineers, according to word received recently by his parents.

Sgt. Andrews was inducted into the Army August 12 this year. He was promoted from private to corporal about six weeks after induction. According to information received from him by his parents he is engaged in building, maintaining and camouflaging air fields with the aviation engineers, a new Army division.

Previous to his induction, Sgt. Andrews was a member of the Pennsylvania National Guard for four years. He graduated from Liberty High School with the class of 1921. He was employed for 12 years before his induction with the New Jersey Highway Engineering Department as an inspector.
