In Hospital In England**

Wounded several months ago while in action in the African theater, Sergeant John Gibbons, of 1656 East Thirteenth Street, is confined to and improving in a hospital "somewhere in England."

A native of Girardsville, Sgt. Gibbons had been a resident of Bethlehem for about three years, and was employed by the Dugan Bakery. He left Bethlehem with the 213th Regiment Coast Artillery (Anti-Aircraft), commanded by L. C. Atwood. **SEP 1 1943**

Since being hospitalized he has written a number of letters to members of his family.
