Pvt. Jassmar Gonzales, (above), formerly of Hellertown R. D. 1, has been seriously wounded in action in Italy, according to a telegram from the U. S. War Department received by his wife, Mrs. Helen Gonzales. The family home is now along Bethlehem R. D. 4. Pvt. Gonzales has been in the Army for the past eighteen months. Sent to New Cumberland at the time of his induction he received his training at Camp Croft, S. C., and was then sent overseas. Prior to entering the service he was employed in the coke plant of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
