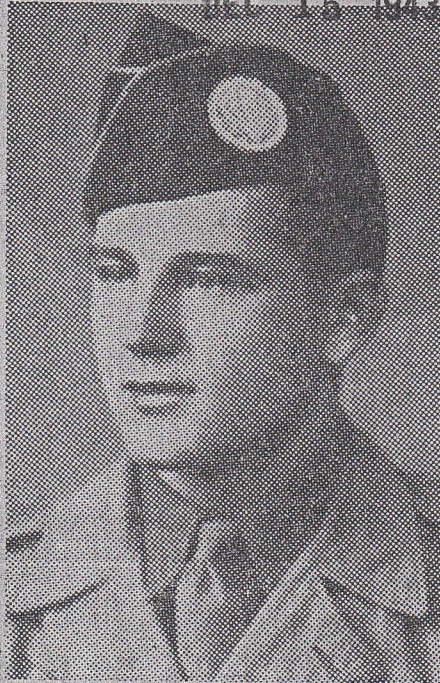


ROZSA, William L.

Rozsa, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Rozsa, 812 Evans Street, this city, has recovered from injuries suffered in the European war theater and has been released from a hospital, according to word received by his parents. He was injured September 28, according to the War Department, and released from the hospital November 18. He entered the service February 17, 1942 and was sent overseas last April. He graduated as a paratrooper and had been attached to the Fifth Army. He is a graduate of Liberty High School and has a brother, Rev. Eugene A. Rozsa, Presbyterian pastor, at Hartford, Conn., and a sister in Philadelphia.
