Friedensville Soldiers Killed, Parents Told

Mr. and Mrs. Fred A. Christman, Friedensville, yesterday received a telegram from the War Department informing them that their son, Pvt. Fred A. Christman a member of Co. A. 23rd Infantry, was killed in action in France, June 22.

Pvt. Christman entered the service in January, 1941, and received his basic training at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, and later was transferred to Camp McCoy, Wis. In September, 1943, he was sent to Ireland and from there to England. The parents heard from him about a month ago.

Besides his parents he is survived by two brothers, Robert Christman, Bethlehem, and Allen Christman, Philadelphia; six sisters; Mrs. Al Radle, Bethlehem; Mrs. Horace Ehly, Easton; Mrs. Peter Ehly, Easton; Mrs. Charles Martinuzzi, Friedensville; Mrs. Leroy Rowe, Friedensville, and Mrs. Bertha Gross, Allentown.
