Frey is in the Air Corps and a member of the Eighth Army. He enlisted on July 16, 1942, and took his basic training at Madison, Wisc., graduating as a radio technician. He took up further study at the Harlingen Gunnery School, Texas. Before entering the service he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company as repairman in the rolling mill of the Saucon Plant. The Frey's have two other sons in the service, Pvt. Donald A. Frey, Air Corps, attending radio school at Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and Richard W. Frey, apprentice seaman, who is completing a course to become a machinist mate at the Great Lakes Naval School, Ill.
