Sgt. Thomas Malloy, son of Mrs. John Malloy and the late John Malloy, 845 Juniper Street, Hellertown, has returned home after receiving his discharge from the Army at Indianatown Gap, Sunday. He arrived in the States from Europe last Tuesday, docking at Boston, Mass.

Thomas took part in the D-Day invasion of France and participated in all of the major battles in Germany. He wears the Purple Heart, Good Conduct medal, campaign ribbon with five battle stars and Presidential Unit Citation. Prior to entering the service, April 20, 1942, he was employed by Bethlehem Steel Company.
