Word has been received from Sgt. Thomas A. Gillen, U. S. Army, former teller at the Union Bank and Trust Company of Bethlehem, who

is now serving with the 333rd Bomb Group, on Okinawa, having arrived there last July. Sgt. Gillen wrote that on the trip to the South Pacific he had the good fortune to be assigned to the best detail on the ship, that of making ice cream.

On his first night on Okinawa, he was greeted by a Jap air-raid, but mentioned that they were well protected by night fighters and ack-ack.

In the service since early in 1942, Gillen received training in Texas, Nebraska and New Mexico before leaving the country.
