Oak Leaf Cluster For Ex-Machinist

AN EIGHTH AIR FORCE BOMBER STATION, England—The first Oak Leaf Cluster to his Air Medal, for "courage, coolness and skill" in aerial combat with the Eighth Air Force, has been conferred on Staff Sergeant Joseph Feszchak, 19-year-old B-17 Flying Fortress tail turret gunner, of Plains, Pa. **AUG. 21 1944**

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Sam Feszchak, of 59 Hancock Street, Plains, and formerly a machinist at the Bethlehem Steel Company, Bethlehem, Pa., S/Sgt. Feszchak has seen action over enemy targets ranging from Central Europe to the French coast, aiding in the destruction of key Nazi war plants, military installations and robot bomb sites. His number grey holds a Presidential Citation for manly in action.
