**Pfc. Arthur Solomon
Home After 26
Months in Europe**

Pfc. Arthur C. Solomon, who holds the Presidential Unit Citation, Purple Heart and the French Croix de Guerre, returned to his home last week after serving 26 months overseas in the European Theater.

Pfc. Solomon had a varied military career, having served with the 46th Infantry Division in Rome, Fifth Division in Africa and Italy, and Patton's 10th Armored Division. A sophomore at Temple University at the time of his induction in 1943, he was sent to Camp Walters, Tex., for his basic training, and from there was sent overseas.

In addition to the military decorations mentioned above, Pfc. Solomon also holds the Infantry Badge and wears on his theater ribbons five battle participation stars.

Solomon is a graduate of Allentown elementary schools and Shamokin High School. His parents are Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Solomon, 557 West Third Street.

At the completion of his leave, he will report to Indiantown Gap Military Reservation for discharge.
