Home from the Pacific wearing five battle stars and a Good Conduct Medal, Alvin J. Kaminski, WT2/C, son of Stella and Peter Kaminski, 67 East Garrison Street, is on a 30-day leave from the U. S. Navy. He is assigned to the battleship Wisconsin which took part in bombarding of the islands in Tokyo Bay at the time of the surrender. Prior to this, he served on the USS Iowa, which took the late President Roosevelt to his first conference in 1943.

WT2/C Kaminski made three advancements while in the Navy. He

was employed in the Bethlehem Steel Company before enlisting in the Navy in September 1942.
